SCHOOL UNIFORM

Boys (I-VIII)

Light blue shirts with half sleeves and one pocket on left side. Navy blue shorts with two pleats in front and side pockets. Students who are above 145 cm in height should wear navy blue trousers. Loops not less than 5cm (for belt) is to be provided.

Boys (VIII- X)

Light blue shirt with half sleeves and one pocket on left side and navy blue trousers with loops not less than 5cm for belt.

Girls (I-V)

Navy blue pinafore with 'V' neck in the front, round neck at the back, sides open the waist. Box pleats two in the front and two at the back with loops not less than 5cm above each pleat for belt. Length of pinafore up to the knee.

Girls (VI-VII)

Light blue shirt with half sleeves and shirt collar with navy blue half-coat Navy blue pleated skirts, upto the knee. Three box pleats in the front and three box pleats at the back. The pleats

should be 12 cms broad, and 4.5 cms deep on either side of each pleat. Black ribbon with usual uniform for all girls.

Girls (VIII-X)

Navy blue salwar and navy blue half-coat, light blue kameez, closed round neck with two hooks at the back, plain loose sleeves length one inch above the elbow, length of kameez three inches below the knee with slits of 6 inches length at the sides. There should be a pocket on the right side below the waist. Full uniform is compulsory on all working days including days of functions, celebrations etc.

Footwear

Boys :

Plain black shoes with Navy blue socks

Girls :

Plain black shoes with navy blue socks.

Monsoon wear :

Boys & Girls : Plain black foot wear suitable for the season

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fees are payable on or before 10th of every month as per the schedule. After 10th (till the close of the month) fee will have to be deposited along with late fee of Rs. 2/- per day. If 10th is a holiday fees will be collected with out fine on the next working day.
2. Failure to pay the fees by the close of the month will result in the removal of the student from the rolls of the school without prior intimation. In such cases readmission can be sought for on clearing the fees dues with fine and on payment of readmission fee of Rs. 1000/-. Readmission, however, is not a matter of right. Authorities of the schools reserve the right to refuse readmission if they so desire.
3. Parents will keep the fee receipt with them and produce whenever required by the school.
4. Parents have the option to deposit fees for a whole term or the whole year in advance.

5. In case of doubt regarding the payment of dues, parents will deal directly with the school office between 9.30 am and 1.30 pm on all working days.

School Conveyance

School buses are available for conveying students to and fro from various important points fixed for the purpose. However, this facility is optional and cannot be claimed by the student as a matter of right. Requests from parents for bus facility should be submitted well in advance preferably before the commencement of the academic year. Bus fee will be collected in advance.

Attendance

No student who has less than 80% attendance to his/her credit in particular academic year shall be considered for promotion. Unauthorised absence for a period of 30 days will result in removal of the pupil's name from the rolls without any intimation to the parent. Long absence may be condoned at the discretion of the School Managing Committee upto class VIII. For absence from school for a period of more than three days (due to any illness) leave will be granted only if application is accompanied by a Medical Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner.

The School Assembly

The morning session begins with the assembly which all the students and members of staff are expected to join. After the prayer, pledge taking and short speeches by the Teacher in-charge, students or members of the staff, and Bhavan's anthem, the regular classes for the day will start. During the assembly, the students have to observe proper decorum and solemnity befitting the occasion.

Tests and Examinations

The following tests and examinations will be held in an academic year.

Class tests and other internal assessments will also be conducted regularly as per CBSE guidelines.

Library

We have a full-fledged library with good books comprising of titles in all subjects and also for general reading to inculcate reading habit in students. English & Malayalam newspapers and good magazines and periodicals are also provided.

Bhavan's Students

4. Know that cruelty and causing pain to others is the trait of a bully while kindness is the mark of a gentle boy or girl.
5. Never make fun of the old or the poor, neither make fun of companions because of a misfortune or a handicap which he/she cannot help,
6. Respect and maintain the neatness of their class room and the school premises and report any damage they may observe.
7. Learn and observe good table manners in library and else where.
8. Are always truthful.
9. Try to contribute their share in making the world a better place to live, instead of lamenting and grumbling about the evils of this world.

General Instructions

1. Assignments shall be regularly done and submitted.
2. Indifference to any subject, discourtesy towards any member of staff or any act which affects the discipline or tone of the school will be dealt with seriously.
3. Cleanliness in person and clothes is expected of every child. Students coming to school with untidy dress, hair, etc., will not be permitted to attend school.
4. No child suffering from any contagious or infectious disease will be permitted to attend school.
5. Habitual negligence in school work, tardiness, dishonesty or other acts of misconduct will involve severe disciplinary action including expulsion in extreme cases.

6. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and belongings
7. Any damage done to school property or to that of other students will have to be made good.
8. The school premises should be kept neat and tidy.
9. Students from one class are not allowed to be in other classrooms during the interval.
10. Every student must bring his/her diary to the class daily. It should not be used as a rough book. Pages therein should not be torn and it shall always be kept in neat and tidy condition.
11. Students should not wear costly ornaments.
12. Boys must have their hair cut short and girls should keep their hair well - groomed.

For the Information of Parents

1. Parents/guardians are welcome to school, to enquire about the progress of their children. **They should meet the teachers only by previous appointment through the principal.**
2. Fetching children from classes during the school time is not permitted. Parents who wish to take their children to hospital, etc. are advised not to send their children to school for a session or a day as the case may be and should send a leave-note to the class teacher.
3. Please make sure that the child comes to school in proper school uniform even if it is for a short duration and for any purpose whatsoever.

4. In case your child is travelling by your own transport, please ensure that he/she reaches school on time.
5. Please inform the class teacher when there is a change in the address/telephone number.
6. The school will be sending notes, circular, etc. through students. from time to time and receipt of which may please be acknowledged in the space provided in the diary.
7. Please go through the progress reports issued periodically and take suitable steps.
